

REPORT ON INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

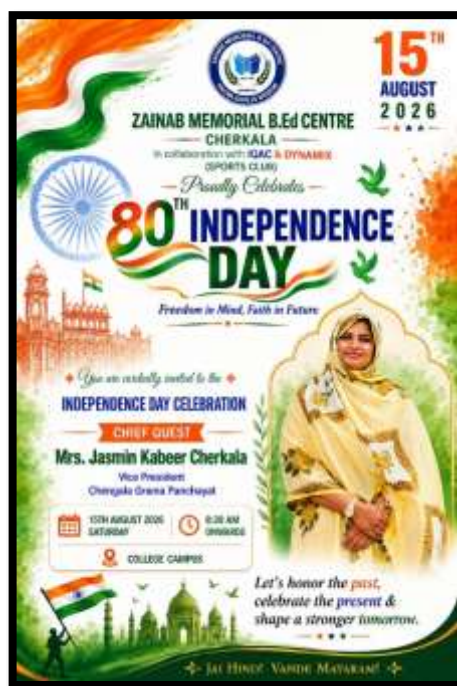
